Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), New Delhi and the South Asia Regional Office of United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), New Delhi are cosponsoring a Science Olympiad for Science students of 11th Standard/Class or equivalent in South Asian countries—Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka. All students who have scored a minimum of 70% average in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the terminal examination of 10th Standard/Class or equivalent are eligible to participate. They should register for participation in this Olympiad along with a recent photograph with signature pasted on their application, a certification for having obtained a minimum of 70% average in the science subjects of their 10th Standard/Class examination. **Registration is limited to government and government affiliated schools.**

Registration can be done in a proforma found in the websites of IGNOU and UNESCO. School principals/authorities are requested to promote the participation of all bright students and forward the applications from their respective schools. Successful participants will receive certificates of merit, medals, cash prizes and awards. *Top 1000 participants will be given IGNOU-UNESCO accredited merit certificates. About thirty meritorious participants from the SAARC countries will be invited to take the second test and to receive the awards in person in a special award ceremony.* Last date for registration is July 25, 2010. Tier test I (objective test) will be held on 22nd August 2010 from 10.a.m to 1.00 p.m. in Sri Lanka and top 30 performer students from the SAARC region will be invited to IGNOU, New Delhi for the 2nd tier test which will be held on 13th November 2010 followed by a talk by 5 toppers. Awards of certificates will be held on 14th November 2010 at the IGNOU, New Delhi.
